



SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Ascension Press is committed to publishing popular Catholic books, Bible studies, and faith formation resources that speak to the needs—and touch the hearts—of today’s Catholics. Our current product focus includes developing our *Great Adventure* Bible Study System, our Theology of Body offerings, and our *Epic* Church History program, among other catechetical and faith formation resources.

We strategically publish only a limited number of books per year, focusing considerable marketing resources on each title. We generally seek the “most popular” ideas, i.e., titles that are being requested by the Catholic community rather than those that require us to “force the need.”

Considerations

Authors who wish to submit a proposal and/or manuscript to Ascension Press should keep the following points in mind:

- We seek proposals and/or manuscripts that inform and inspire adult Catholics, works that bring Catholics to a deeper understanding of their faith and help them grow in their relationship with God. We seek to publish “popular” rather than scholarly or academic works, i.e., books and products that speak to average Catholic “in the pew.”
- Priority consideration is given to book and product proposals that can be integrated with our existing faith formation programs and systems. A proposal and/or manuscript is evaluated in light of its potential integration with our existing programs and our ability to develop and market it successfully.
- We only publish works that faithfully reflect the official teachings of the Church’s Magisterium.
- We generally do not publish works that are about (or include substantial portions connected with) private revelations.
- We do not publish works of fiction or poetry.

What to Submit

Proposals and/manuscript submissions to Ascension Press should include the following:

- A brief cover letter summarizing the content of your work, along with its approximate length, intended audience, and any unique factors you believe set it apart from similar books/products currently on the market.
- A table of contents.
- At minimum, a sample chapter (assuming that an entire draft manuscript is not submitted)
- A brief biographical sketch or curriculum vitae.
- Any endorsements for your book or proposal.
- Your ideas for its promotion and marketing.

Upon receipt, our editorial committee will review your proposal and/or manuscript to determine whether it fits our publishing needs. Please allow **eight to twelve weeks** for a response.

How to Send Us Your Proposal

We prefer to receive proposals via email, as this streamlines the review process by allowing us to easily forward materials to our entire editorial team.
